ENTERPRISING GIRL SCOUT TROOP 1980 ACHIEVES AMAZING FUNDRAISING RESULTS WITH ARTISTIC CALENDAR PROJECT AND PLANS TO PRESENT THEIR CHECK TO MOSTLY MUTTS ON MARCH 3

KENNESAW – The 4th graders of local Girl Scout Troop 1980 are passionate about animals and decided to do something to help homeless pets in their community. They approached Mostly Mutts Animal Rescue last September with an idea for a fundraising calendar. Not only are they animal lovers, but they are talented and creative artists as well. They came to our rescue facility to meet adoptable dogs and cats, and then they drew, painted and photographed the animals. The finished calendar was an outstanding and heart-warming way to showcase adoptable animals and bring awareness about homeless pets.

Troop 1980 also partnered with Star Printing Company in Acworth, another big supporter of Mostly Mutts, that graciously printed 150 calendars at no charge. The Girl Scouts then distributed the calendars in return for donations to Mostly Mutts, and were very successful thanks to much hard work and dedication.

“We are so looking forward to welcoming the girls from Troop 1980 for the official presentation of their fundraising check at 2:00 pm on Saturday, March 3 at our pet rescue and adoption facility (3238 Cherokee Street in Kennesaw), said Tammy Turley, Executive Director. “It means so much to our organization that children in the community have such a strong desire to help us save more homeless pets, they are setting a great example,” said Tammy.

Mostly Mutts strives to reduce the number of animals euthanized at local shelters in Metro Atlanta by working with animal control officers to save adoptable dogs that are moments away from being put to sleep. Often, these dogs are sick, injured and require rehabilitation. Mostly Mutts provides housing, health care, training, and physical and emotional care to these rescued animals until they can be placed in a new “forever home.”

Mostly Mutts is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, licensed by the Dept. of Agriculture and staffed by volunteers. It is privately funded through donations and adoption fees.
